

2012 DONALD A. BALDWIN SR. BUSINESS AVIATION MANAGEMENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The family of the late Donald A. Baldwin Sr., in coordination with the Corporate Aviation Management Committee of the National Business Aviation Association (NBAA), established the Donald A. Baldwin Sr. Business Aviation Management Scholarship in 2007 to benefit individuals seeking to become NBAA Certified Aviation Managers (CAMs). The scholarship promotes professional development in business aviation by providing financial support for qualified CAM exam candidates.

Baldwin, an accomplished general aviation pilot and beloved father, was a member of NBAA's Board of Directors from 1968 to 1971. He was recognized for his contributions to business aviation with the NBAA John P. "Jack" Doswell Award in 1992 and the Flight Safety Foundation Business Aviation Meritorious Service Award in 1991.

This scholarship will be awarded by February 2012, and will be redeemable under the conditions established by NBAA and the family of Donald A. Baldwin Sr. Funds for this scholarship will total \$1,225 for one person and will cover the cost of the CAM application, *CAM Study Guide* and CAM exam registration fee. Funds also will be provided for recipients to attend the 2012 NBAA Leadership Conference. Recipients are responsible for other costs associated with the scholarship, such as travel and lodging expenses. NBAA scholarship applicants are limited to receiving one award per person, per year.

The Baldwin Business Aviation Management Scholarship is one of several scholarships offered by NBAA to promote professional development and business aviation careers. For more information, visit www.nbaa.org/scholarships.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant must be eligible to take the CAM Exam within two years of the date of the scholarship award, which is February 2012.
2. Applicant must meet the minimum qualifications to take the CAM exam by submitting a completed CAM application to NBAA by **November 15, 2011**. Applicant must score greater than 100 points on the CAM application, which is available at www.nbaa.org/cam.
3. Fill out this application form in its entirety and sign it.
4. Submit a 250-word, typed, double-spaced essay describing your interest in and goals for a career in the business aviation industry, and how CAM certification will help you achieve those goals. Your typed name must appear at the top of the page.
5. Submit a current one-page resume with permanent home address.
6. Submit two letters of recommendation from those qualified to comment on your career aspirations and qualifications, especially as they relate to business aviation.
7. Completed application package, which includes this form, one essay, one resume and two letters of recommendation, must be received by NBAA no later than **November 15, 2011**, to be considered for the scholarship. The CAM application must be submitted separately by that date.
